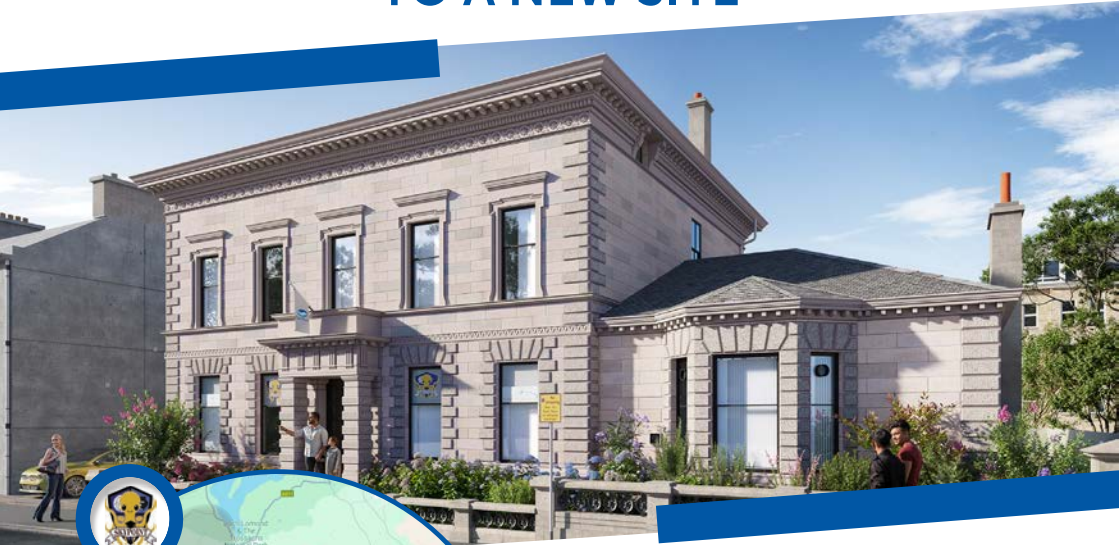

Skypoint School is an Independent Specialist School.

We provide specialist education to young people aged from 7 to 18 years, a proportion of whom are Looked After Children, all with a range of needs, such as ASD, ADHD, Learning Difficulties, SEMH, and associated conditions.

The capacity is 50, this is spread across the Broad General Education and Senior Phase.

Pupils come to us from a number of different authorities including West Dunbartonshire, East Dunbartonshire, Edinburgh, Renfrewshire, East Renfrewshire, Argyll and Bute, North Lanarkshire, South Lanarkshire and more given our new location.



Skypoint has a wide range of facilities on-site including; large multi-purpose room, woodwork department, music studio, hospitality kitchen and an outdoor playground. The building has several rooms to allow smaller groups of pupils to access support from a high ratio of staff, this allows us to offer a broad range of experiences at all stages and levels.
